108th Air Defense Artillery Complex going up at Fort Bragg



The Savannah District's Barracks Resident Office is well underway on \$140 million in facilities for the 108th Air Defense Artillery at Fort Bragg. Awarded as two separate contracts to ACC Construction of Augusta, Ga., and Caddell Construction of Montgomery, Ala., the complex includes four, 4-story barracks, two battalion headquarters, two company operations facilities, a tactical equipment and maintenance facility and full sitework. Estimated completion is late 2010.
