Hartwell Dam Fishing Pier and Georgia River Recreation Area to close temporarily April 26-27

SAVANNAH, Ga. – The [U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Savannah District](#) will temporarily close the Georgia River Recreation Area and the fishing pier located directly below the [Hartwell Dam](#) to the general public on Thursday, April 26 at 4 p.m. through Friday, April 27 at 8 p.m.

The temporary closure is necessary to accommodate an invitation only ceremony commemorating the 50th Anniversary of Hartwell Dam and Lake.

Immediately following the event, the pier and recreation area will re-open to the public. All fishing piers located in the South Carolina River Recreation Area will remain open to the public.
