Jeremy C. Keels assumed duties as the Executive Assistant and Congressional Liaison for the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Savannah District in September 2015. In his current position, Keels serves as a liaison between members of Congress and the Corps of Engineers. He is responsible for coordinating congressional inquiries, situation reports, public hearings, congressional meetings, and District events.

The Savannah District oversees a multi-million dollar military construction program at 11 Army and Air Force Installations in Georgia and North Carolina; water resource activities in eastern Georgia and portions of South Carolina; and wetland protection in Georgia. The Savannah District supports 11 Army and Air Force installations in Georgia and North Carolina, and water resource activities in Georgia and portions of South Carolina. The Savannah District performs work nationwide and worldwide in support of military design and construction; master planning; hazardous, toxic and radioactive waste clean-up at Formerly Used Defense sites; real estate activities for the Department of Defense; emergency management operations for state and federal agencies and in support of Overseas Contingency Operations.

Keels began his civilian career with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers in 2010 and has held various positions in both the civil works and military programs. Before his current assignment as Executive Assistant/Congressional Liaison, he served as a Realty Specialist for military programs and civil works projects.

Throughout his career, Keels has served in the U.S. Navy as an Executive Assistant to several three-star Admirals assigned to Commander, 7th Fleet based in Yokosuka, Japan. Additionally, Keels coordinated high level events such as the G-8 Summit, hosting eight countries (Canada, France, Germany, Italy, Japan, Russia, United Kingdom, and United States). Keels military experience includes serving as a Staff Writer-Editor, Congressional Liaison and Event Planner for the command and U.S. and foreign government officials.

Keels holds a Bachelor Degree in Visual Communication. He has also completed an array of government-sponsored training in areas of real estate and federal acquisition.

Among his military awards are Naval Achievement Medals, the Global War on Terrorism Service Medal, and Good Conduct Medals.
