Available Hartwell Lake Volunteer Positions – 2014

Park Host Volunteers

This is a volunteer position with Savannah District, U. S. Army Corps of Engineers, Hartwell Lake Project. The incumbent is assigned responsibilities and duties which supplement the efforts of the Corps to manage the public lands and waters to provide quality recreation services and facilities. Volunteers must be able to provide a high level of customer service.

Duties include, but are not limited to:

1. Performs one inspection (observations) daily of the assigned recreation area. Be available to assist visitors in the day use area on Saturday and Sunday.
2. Empty and dispose of trash within the recreation area. Pick up litter as needed.
3. Monitor restroom facilities daily and clean and stock as needed. Facilities consist of one men's and one women's restroom.
4. Monitor entrance gate to insure visitors obtain day use fee envelopes and placing visitor notes on violators. Advise visitors of minor corrections such as (parking on grass, dog off leash).
5. Assist with the Water Safety and Life Jacket Loaner Programs as needed.
6. Reports vandalism immediately to the Corps office and County Sheriff Department.
7. Reports any unusual findings to the corps office or County Sheriff Department as soon as practical.
8. Suggests (upon observation) recommendations to improve facilities and providing for improved public safety.

GOVERNMENT PROVIDED PROPERTY

The government will provide one camping site with electrical, sewer, potable water, and telephone hook ups in exchange for the duties described above. Telephone service will be limited to local calls only and any long distance calls (except business related calls) must be billed to a calling card or charged to your home phone. **All equipment, supplies, and uniform items will be provided by the Corps.**

Volunteers must maintain a valid driver's license. Volunteers may use a golf cart or similar vehicle while performing assigned duties. Prior approval is required. No vehicles/transportation will be provided by the government.

Volunteers will average 25-30 hours of service per week. Volunteer will be bonded and subject to background checks.
