In an effort to reduce waste, save money, and streamline communication with the public, the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Savannah District, Regulatory Division will implement a new electronic notification system for Public Notices effective April 4, 2013.

The Corps will send e-mail notifications to Public Notices subscribers, via e-mail, rather than mail paper copies. Additionally, the new system allows subscribers to customize their preferences and receive Public Notices from five different regions in Georgia, or for the entire state.

Starting June 1, 2013, only those individuals or groups, who subscribe to the new system, will receive electronic notification or printed copies of Public Notices. To subscribe, please complete the attached form and e-mail to CESAS-RD-ESubmittal@usace.army.mil; or fax to 912-652-5995; or mail to: U.S. Army Corps of Engineers ATTN: CESAS-RD, 100 West Oglethorpe Avenue, Savannah, Georgia 31401-3640. The form can also be accessed on our website at <http://www.sas.usace.army.mil/Missions/Regulatory/PublicNotices> and filled out electronically. You can modify or cancel your subscription at any time by submitting a revised form or by contacting our office.

E-mails will be sent the same day a Public Notice is published and will include a project summary, as well as a link to the complete Public Notice on our website.

If you do not have Internet access and wish to continue receiving printed copies of our notices, please fill out the attached form and provide a short justification explaining why printed copies are needed.

Additionally, the Savannah District posts all Public Notices on the social networks Facebook and Twitter at www.facebook.com/savannahcorps and www.twitter.com/savannahcorps. The District uses these social media sites to communicate public information about Corps' projects and programs, including information about the Regulatory Program. Anyone with a Facebook or Twitter account is encouraged to follow us on these sites.

People who own property adjacent to an application site will continue to receive notification of Public Notices. However, instead of receiving a complete paper copy, they will receive a post card with general information about the project and a link to the complete Public Notice on our website. Postcards will also include a number to call to obtain a paper copy.

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers is required by Federal regulation to prepare Public Notices advertising applications for Department of the Army standard permits to solicit public comments. For applications involving Section 404 of the Clean Water Act, these notices also advertise the Georgia Department of Natural Resources, Environmental Protection Division's intention to certify a project in accordance with the provisions of Section 401 of the Clean Water Act.

The Savannah District launched a new website on March 15 and thus all web links have changed. Users who have book marked pages other than the homepage (www.sas.usace.army.mil) will need to update their Internet "bookmarks" or "favorites." All Public Notices are now posted on the new Public Notice page at: <http://www.sas.usace.army.mil/Missions/Regulatory/PublicNotices>. The new website is much more user-friendly and provides easy access to Public Notices and other Corps information.

Remember you must subscribe using the attached form, by May 31, 2013, to receive electronic notification or printed copies of Public Notices. ROUTINE USES: Utilized to develop mailing lists for distribution of Corps Regulatory Public Notices. This information is a public record and may be disclosed to other Federal or local agencies for governmental purposes as well as to private individuals and organizations under the Freedom of Information Act.
