Savannah District Completes \$86.3M 3rd Brigade Barracks at Fort Bragg



The Savannah District is nearing completion on an \$86.3 million barracks project for the Soldiers of Fort Bragg. The two, six-story barracks sleep 768 Soldiers. Each suite includes two private bedrooms and a shared kitchen and bathroom. The contract was awarded to ACC Construction of Augusta, Ga., and full completion of the barracks is scheduled for January 2010.
