2. NWP 7 - EVIDENCE THAT A NPDES PERMIT HAS BEEN OBTAINED.
3. NWP 7 (MAINTENANCE)- MUST INCLUDE INFORMATION REGARDING ORIGINAL DESIGN CAPACITIES AND CONFIGURATIONS OF THE AREA TO BE DREDGED.
4. NWP 21 - MUST SUBMIT AN OFFICE OF SURFACE MINING OR STATE APPROVED MITIGATION PLAN.
5. NWP 27 - MUST DOCUMENT PRIOR CONDITION OF THE SITE.
6. NWP 29 - MUST INCLUDE ANY PAST USE OF NWP 29; STATEMENT THAT WORK IS FOR A PERSONAL RESIDENCE; DESCRIPTION OF THE ENTIRE PARCEL; AND A WRITTEN DESCRIPTION OF ALL LAND OWNED BY THE APPLICANT WITHIN 1 MILE RADIUS OF THE PARCEL.
7. NWP 31 - MUST INCLUDE SUFFICIENT BASELINE INFORMATION ON THE CHANNEL, A DELINEATION OF WETLANDS, AND LOCATION OF DISPOSAL SITE.
8. NWP 33 - MUST INCLUDE A RESTORATION PLAN
9. NWP 43 - FOR NEW FACILITIES MUST INCLUDE A MAINTENANCE PLAN.
10. NWP 44 - NEED DESCRIPTION OF ALL WATER IMPACTED, MEASURES TAKEN TO MINIMIZE IMPACT, AND A RECLAMATION PLAN.
