Dear Ms. Singleton:

Staff of the Coastal Management Program has reviewed the above referenced joint public notice pursuant to Section 404 of the Clean Water Act and/or Section 10 of the River and Harbors Act of 1899 for consistency with the Georgia Coastal Management Program (GCMP). The project proposes to issue four Regional General Permits to expedite American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) projects.

The Program **objects** with the applicant's consistency certification. This certification ensures that the proposed project has been designed to comply with the applicable enforceable policies of the GCMP and that all applicable state permits have been obtained prior to issuance of this federal permit. At this point in time, a Section 401 Water Quality Certification has not been issued for this project. Once a Section 401 has been issued, the Program will review this proposed project again for consistency with the Georgia Coastal Management Program.
