Major Vance C. Williams became Deputy Commander of the Savannah District, US Army Corps of Engineers on August 15, 2003, after serving as Operations Officer for the 30th Engineer Battalion at Ft. Bragg, NC .

A 1986 graduate of the University of Virginia with a Bachelor of Science Degree in Systems Engineering, Major Williams also holds a Master of Business Administration from Jacksonville State University. His military education includes the Engineer Officer Basic and Advance Courses, Airborne Course, the Combined Arms Services Staff School, the Command and General Staff College, the Resource Management Business Course and the Topographic Officer Management Course.

Major Williams was commissioned in the Corps of Engineers in May 1986 and commanded the Headquarters and Headquarter Company, 40th Engineer Battalion of the 1st Armored Division in Baumholder, Germany. His staff assignments include executive and operations officer, 30th Engineer Battalion, Fort Bragg, NC; Staff Engineer for the 1st COSCOM, NC; Logistics Officer for the 20th Engineer Brigade, Ft Bragg, NC; OIC of the Reserve Officer Training Corps detachment and Assistant Professor of Military Science, Penn State-Altoona; and Resource Manager for the US Army Military Police School, Ft. McClellan, Alabama.

Major Williams' awards include the Bronze Star, the Meritorious Service Medal (four awards), the Army Commendation Medal, and the Army Achievement Medal (three awards).
