Jeremy C. Keels assumed the role as the Executive Officer and Congressional Liaison for the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Savannah District in 2015. As the Executive Officer, Jeremy assists the Commander and deputies in consultation with District staff in the executive direction of District programs. As Congressional Liaison, Mr. Keels advises and performs as a liaison on matters of mutual concern for Congressional offices, Federal agencies, state and local municipalities, and industry in relation to the planning and development of water resources for the geographical area of responsibility of the Savannah District.

The Savannah District oversees a multi-million dollar military construction program at 11 Army and Air Force Installations in Georgia and North Carolina; water resource activities in eastern Georgia and portions of South Carolina; and wetland protection in Georgia. The Savannah District performs work nationwide and worldwide in support of military design and construction; master planning; hazardous, toxic and radioactive waste clean-up at Formerly Used Defense sites; real estate activities for the Department of Defense; emergency management operations for state and federal agencies and in support of Overseas Contingency Operations.

Mr. Keels began his federal civilian career with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers in 2010 and has held various positions in both Civil Works and Military programs. Prior to his current assignment as Executive Officer/Congressional Liaison, he served as a Realty Specialist in U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Savannah District Real Estate Division.

Prior to joining the Army Corps of Engineers, Mr. Keels served in the U.S. Navy as Executive Assistant to several 3 Star Admirals assigned to Commander, SEVENTH Fleet based in Yokosuka, Japan onboard the USS Blue Ridge (LCC-19). During his overseas assignment, Jeremy provided support to World Leaders during the G8 Summit, hosting 8 countries (Canada, France, Germany, Italy, Japan, Russia, United Kingdom, and United States). Keels military experience also includes serving as a Staff Writer-Editor, Congressional Liaison and Event Planner for U.S. Naval commands in collaboration with foreign government officials and staff.

Mr. Keels holds a Bachelor Degree in Visual Communication. He has also completed an array of federal government training in Leadership Development, Real Estate, and Federal Acquisition.
