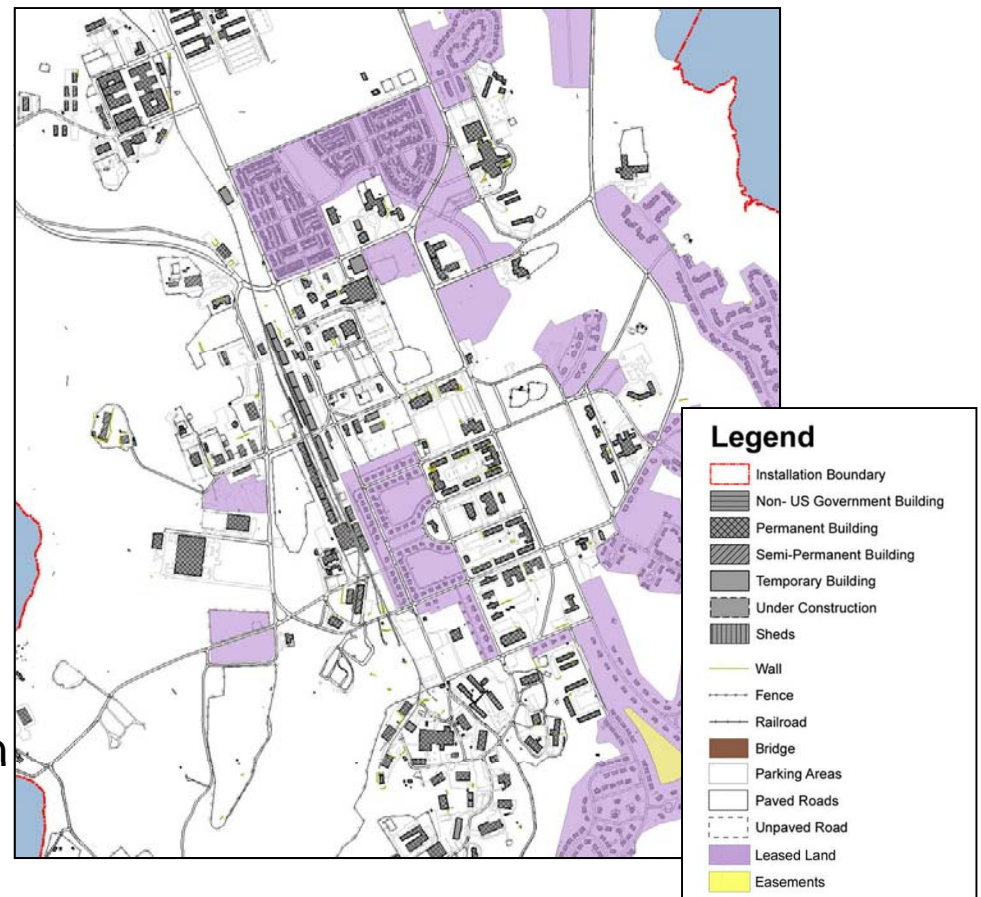


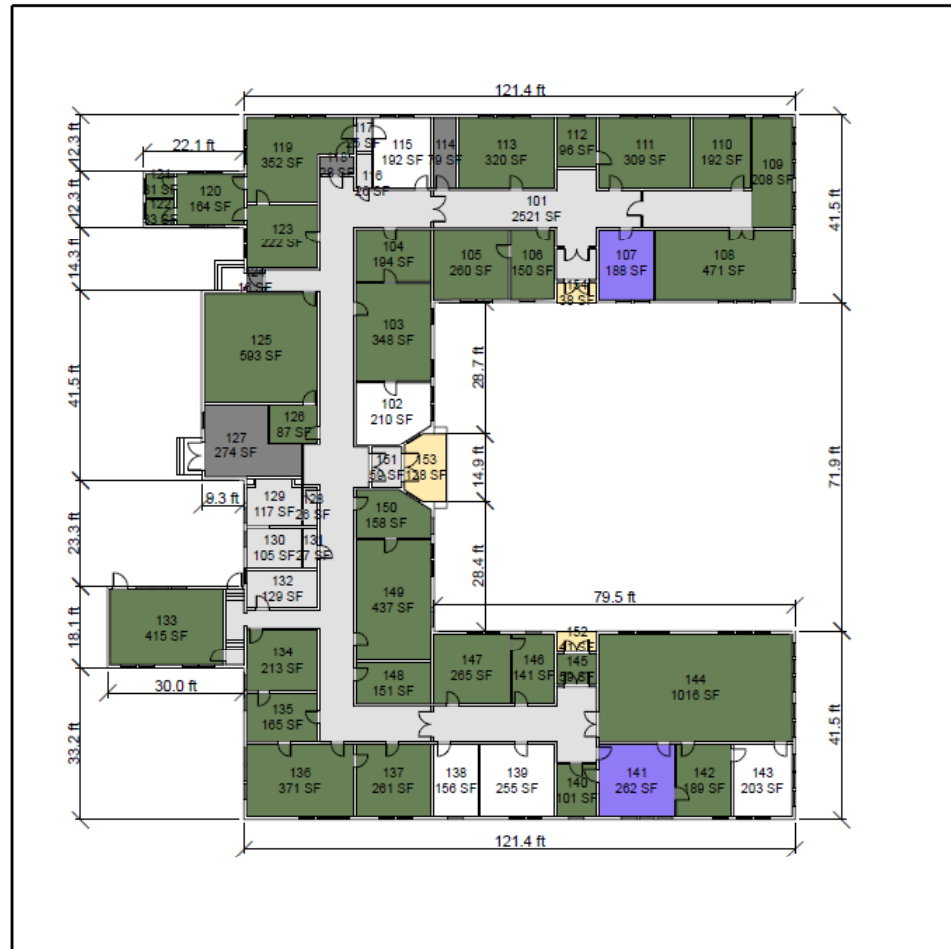
Space Utilization Studies

Space Utilization Studies assist the Garrison Commander in space planning and management to maximize the efficient use of land, facilities, and space to support assigned missions. The objectives of space planning and management are to use existing facilities, property, and space in an efficient manner, to reduce the need to construct, rent, lease, or otherwise acquire land and facilities by using existing Army controlled facilities, to determine any shortfalls or excesses of assigned land, facilities, and space consistent with unit and or activity populations in the Army Stationing and Installation Plan (ASIP), to take action to deal with shortfalls or excesses, and to dispose of land, facilities, or space excess to Army needs.

Space planning guidance is contained in AR 405-70, Utilization of Real Property.
