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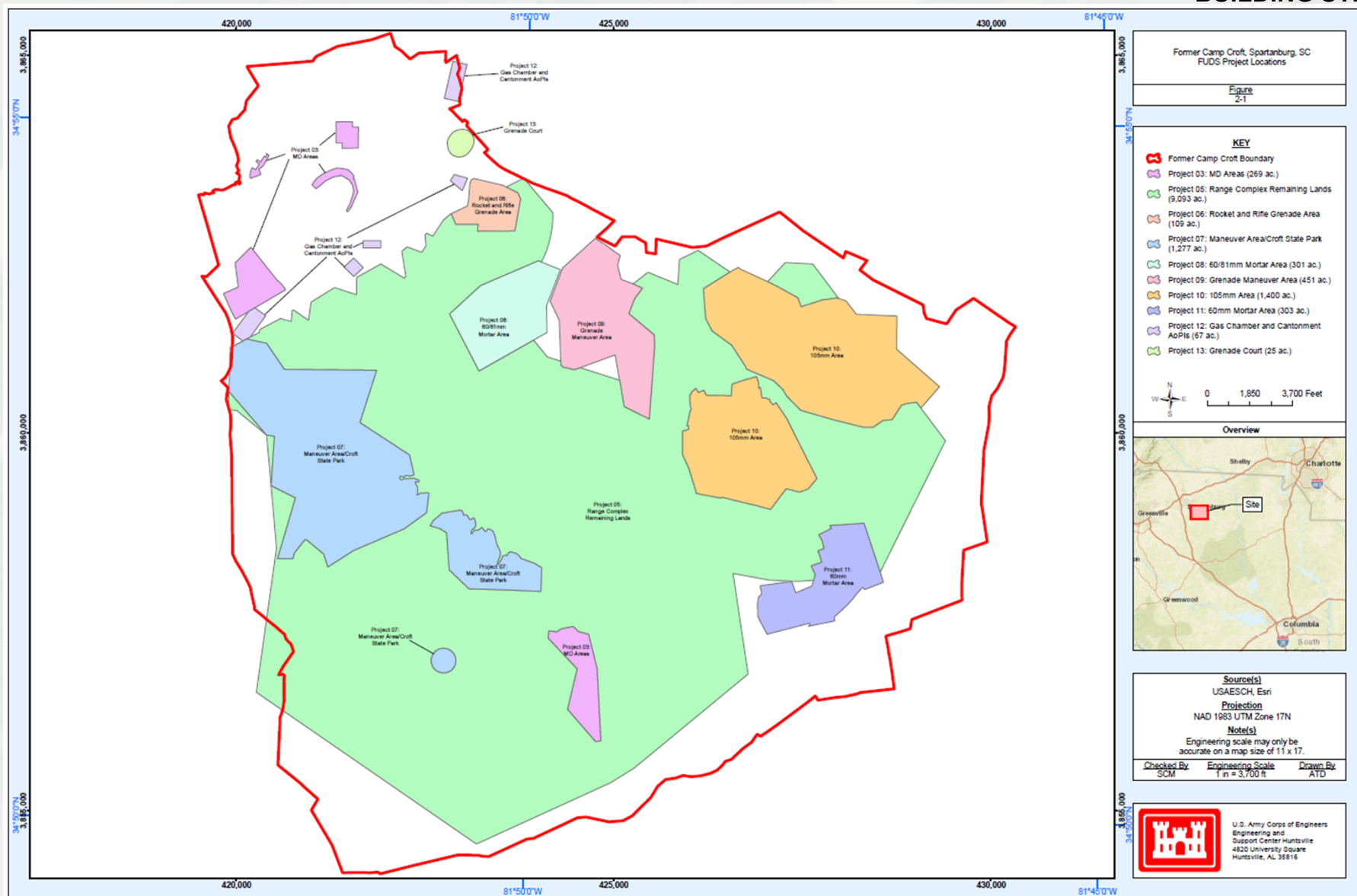

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Camp Croft FUDS Property Update Remedial Action



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Project 03/05

- ▶ Remedial Action (RA) implemented in June 2020 (Public education – 3Rs)

Project 07

- ▶ RA initiated in March 2020 (MEC Surface and Surface Clearance and Public education - 3Rs and signs, and brochures.
- ▶ Phase I RA contract period of performance ended 31 March 2025.
- ▶ Phase II RA contract was awarded on 30 September 2024. Mobilization to resume field work is tentatively scheduled for late October/early November 2025 (Intrusive Investigation & Vegetation Removal).

Project 03/05/07

- ▶ Annual O&M planned for FY26
 - Inspection and maintenance (as needed) of warning signs
 - Reproduction and mailing of educational brochures
 - Coordinate distribution of educational brochures with Spartanburg County for building and land disturbance permits



RAB Membership



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- RAB Members shall serve a two-year term, at which time they may re-submit an application to serve another two-year term (RAB By-laws section A)
 - ▶ Request confirmation of interest from current RAB members and submission of applications by 1 September 2025
 - ▶ USACE to solicit interest from public to serve on RAB in Fall of 2025. Will include solicitations with post cards mailed in October 2025.
- RAB Community Chair shall be elected annually, shall be held for one year with re-election restricted to one additional term (RAB By-laws section V)
 - ▶ Request confirmation of interest by Gary Hayes to continue as Community Chair
 - ▶ ***RAB to vote***



RAB Membership



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A. Community Members

Community members provide information; seek independent technical advice when appropriate and feasible; communicate public concerns to the RAB; and provide information and progress reports to the public. Community Members may include, but are not limited to the following:

Landowners, local residents, (local government, business community, school districts, local environmental groups/activists, civic/public organizations, religious community, local regulatory agencies, home ownership associations, medical community, economically disadvantaged, and African American, Native American, Hispanic, and other minorities) so as to comply with the Executive Order on Environmental Justice 12898.

- The Camp Croft RAB shall consist of no more than nine members.
- The RAB Members shall serve a two-year term, at which time they may re-submit an application to serve another two-year term.
- Prospective RAB members will submit an application to the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers for approval.
- All Members of the RAB shall follow the Camp Croft RAB I V. on attendance, and informal Robert's Rules of Order for cour

member has received prior approval from the RAB.

- I. If any RAB member** is unable to fully participate, the member should submit a written resignation to a RAB chairperson. Resigning members are permitted to recommend or designate new members to replace them. Replacement members will also be sought from those individuals who were

V. The Election of the Community Chair

The Community Chair shall be elected annually by a majority vote of RAB Members by written ballot. For the initial election, names of individuals who have expressed an interest to serve as Chair will be placed on a ballot. A Chair will be selected by a majority vote of the RAB. For subsequent elections, a Nomination Committee of three Community Members may be appointed by the Community Chair to recommend a nominee for the Community Chair. Other members may be nominated from the floor. Write-in candidates and self-nomination are other avenues for election to the Community Chair position. Written ballots will be counted, and the results announced. The elected Chair position shall be held for one year with re-election restricted to one additional term. The Chair-elect will assume office at the next RAB meeting.



Next RAB meeting



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- RAB meetings are scheduled on a quarterly basis but not required by the by-laws
 - ▶ *RAB to vote on whether to codify that meetings should occur first Thursday of February, May, August and November*
- Next RAB meeting is tentatively scheduled for 6 November 2025
