Technical experts can be made available to the RAB. RAB members will be expected to be available to community members and groups to facilitate the exchange of information and/or concerns between the community and the RAB. RAB members can expect to devote approximately 6 to 8 hours quarterly (24 to 32 hours annually) to the RAB. RAB members will receive no compensation for their service.
