A stand-alone TNW determination should be completed following applicable guidance and should NOT be documented on the AJD form. ⁴ Some excluded waters, such as (b)(2) and (b)(4), may not be specifically identified on the AJD form unless a requestor specifically asks a Corps district to do so. Corps Districts may, in case-by-case instances, choose to identify some or all of these waters within the review area.

- **B.** Typical year assessment(s): At the time of field verification, the climatic conditions were normal, per Antecedent Precipitation Calculator (i.e. the seven-day rolling average of documented precipitation for the review area was within the 30%-70% probability for the area based on the historic weather station data records queried).
- C. Additional comments to support AJD: These two wetlands meet the three parameters for identification. These wetlands are adjacent to an old rail line and there is a ditch that runs along the rail line. The ditch did not have any indicators of an OHWM and thus was not a stream and do not provide for at least seasonal flow. These wetlands are not adjacent to a TNW. These wetlands are not adjacent to any JD wetland or water.

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
