- C. Additional comments to support AJD: Drainage basin is 0.04 square miles at most. Feature flows only in direct response to precipitation. Based on review of requested photographs, LIDAR, Stream Stats and other available information, feature was determined to be ephemeral. Feature meets the definition of a (b)(3) feature under 33 CFR 328.3 Definitions.

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
