B. Typical year assessment(s): Antecedent precipitation tool indicates that the site was wetter than normal during the 30-day rolling average (rainfall during prior periods), and the US Drought Monitor indicates that no drought was present at the time of this inspection, representing a typical year scenario during the delineation of aquatic resources present within the project limits.

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C. Additional comments to support AJD: The 42 linear foot ephemeral feature exhibits flow in the channel immediately after rain events and does not exhibit base flow. The 1'-2' wide channel is situated adjacent to roadside ROW limits and could be influenced by road wash and storm events.

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
