**B.** Typical year assessment(s): The data forms provided by Sligh Environmental Consultants, Inc. indicate that the wetland site assessment of the property was performed on 11/02/2020. Using the Antecedent Precipitation Tool Version 1.0, which used rainfall data from a nearby weather station, we have determined
