- **B.** Typical year assessment(s): The APT indicated normal conditions for the site visit conducted on June 2, 2021. This provides a reasonable level of confidence in the flow regime for these features, since flow was not observed on that date.
- **C.** Additional comments to support AJD: Based on a review of the submitted information, a review of readily available remote tools, and a second site visit by the consultant, these features were determined to be non-jurisdictional ephemeral swales.
