I refer to a letter dated February 2, 2023, and subsequent information transmitted via electronic email and received in our office on March 8, 2023, submitted on your behalf by requesting an approved Jurisdictional Determination (AJD) for an approximately 602.5-acre review area. The subject review area is located west of the intersection of Buddy Reddick Memorial Parkway and Highway 341 in Fort Valley, Peach County, Georgia (latitude: 32.576564, longitude: -83.927176). This request has been assigned number SAS-2023-00187, and it is important that you reference this number in all communication concerning this matter.

We have completed an AJD for this site. I have enclosed an "AJD Memorandum for Record," which details whether aquatic resources present on the site are subject to the jurisdiction of the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers and how the Corps determined jurisdiction.

It has been determined that the referenced property does not contain any wetland areas or other waters of the United States as depicted on the enclosed exhibit entitled "Figure No. 5 West Peach Tract Peach County, Georgia Ortho Aerial Prepared For:

"as prepared by and dated November 29, 2022. Therefore, Department of the Army authorization, pursuant to Section 404 of the Clean Water Act (33 United States Code § 1344), is not required for dredge and/or fill activities on the subject property. This approved JD will remain valid for a period of 5-years unless new information warrants revision prior to that date.

You may request an administrative appeal for any approved JD under the Corps regulations at 33 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) Part 331. Enclosed you will find a Notification of Administrative Appeal Options and Process and Request for Appeal form.

The delineation included herein has been conducted to identify the location and extent of the aquatic resource boundaries and/or the jurisdictional status of aquatic resources for purposes of the Clean Water Act for the particular site identified in this request. This delineation and/or jurisdictional determination may not be valid for the Wetland Conservation Provisions of the Food Security Act of 1985, as amended. If you

or your tenant are USDA program participants, or anticipate participation in USDA programs, you should discuss the applicability of a certified wetland determination with the local USDA service center, prior to starting work.


