JOINT PUBLIC NOTICE Savannah District/State of Georgia

The Savannah District has received an application for a Department of the Army Permit, pursuant to Section 404 of the Clean Water Act (33 U.S.C. § 1344), as follows:

<u>Project Purpose as Proposed by Applicant</u>: The applicant's stated project purpose is to develop a warehouse, distribution and logistics facility with a total of 2,096,000 square feet of space within the Savannah Regional Market/Submarkets. The proposed logistics center would assist and support the continued growth of the Savannah Port.

Location of Proposed Work: The 269.2-acre project site is located adjacent to and east of Hodgeville Road, north of Goshen Road and adjacent to and west of the Effingham Parkway near Rincon, Effingham County, Georgia (Latitude 32.120682° north, Longitude -81.310117°west). The on-site aquatic resources drain to Dasher Creek, then Black Creek to the Savannah River, a Traditional Navigable Waterway (TNW).

Description of Work Subject to the Jurisdiction of the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers: The applicant proposes to impact 6.45-acres of jurisdictional wetland, 1.77-acres of potentially isolated wetlands, 1.20-acres of ditch and 0.39-acre (1,542 linear feet) of intermittent stream for the construction of the warehouse, logistics and distribution facility, and associated infrastructure. Specifically, the applicant would impact the aquatic resources to construct four buildings ranging from 248,000 square feet to 1,040,000 square feet and totaling 2,096,000 square feet, employee parking, truck

parking and general site infrastructure (access, utilities, stormwater management) as part of this facility. To offset the loss in aquatic function associated with the wetland impacts, the applicant has proposed the purchase of 38.72 legacy wetland credits and 8,326.80 legacy stream mitigation credits from a U.S. Army Corps of Engineers approved mitigation bank servicing the area or the in-lieu fee program. The applicant has not proposed mitigation for the impacts to 1.77-acres of potentially isolated wetlands and 1.20-acres of jurisdictional ditch. The project is hydrologically connected to the Lower Savannah River watershed (Hydrologic Unit Code (HUC): 03060109).

BACKGROUND

An aquatic resources delineation review, dated November 8, 2021, verified the delineated limits of the various on-site resources within the review area. This Joint Public Notice announces a request for authorizations from both the Corps and the State of Georgia. The applicant's proposed work may also require local governmental approval.

STATE OF GEORGIA

Water Quality Certification: The Georgia Department of Natural Resources, Environmental Protection Division will review the proposed project for water quality certification, in accordance with the provisions of Section 401 of the Clean Water Act. Prior to issuance of a Department of the Army permit for a project location in, on, or adjacent to the waters of the State of Georgia, review for Water Quality Certification is required. A reasonable period of time, which shall not exceed one year, is established under the Clean Water Act for the State to act on a request for Water Quality Certification, after which, issuance of such a Department of the Army permit may proceed. The Georgia EPD did not require a pre-certification meeting with the applicant, prior to submitting their application for a permit under Section 404 of the Clean Water Act.

<u>State-owned Property and Resources</u>: The applicant may also require assent from the State of Georgia, which may be in the form of a license, easement, lease, permit, or other appropriate instrument.

Marshland Protection: This notice also serves as notification of a request to alter coastal marshlands (under the provision of the Coastal Marshlands Protection Act, Georgia Laws, 1970, p. 939 and as amended), if required. Comments concerning this action should be submitted to the Marsh and Shore Management Section, Coastal Resources Division, Georgia Department of Natural Resources, 1 Conservation Way, Brunswick, Georgia 31523-8600 (Telephone 912-264-7218).

<u>Georgia Coastal Management Program:</u> Prior to the Savannah District Corps of Engineers making a final permit decision on this application, the project must be certified by the Georgia Department of Natural Resources, Coastal Resources Division, to be consistent with applicable provisions of the State of Georgia Coastal Management

Program (15 CFR 930). Anyone wishing to comment on Coastal Management Program certification of this project should submit comments in writing within 30 days of the date of this notice to the Federal Consistency Coordinator, Coastal Management Program, Coastal Resources Division, Georgia Department of Natural Resources, One Conservation Way, Brunswick, Georgia 31523-8600 (Telephone 912-264-7218).

U.S. ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS

The Savannah District must consider the purpose and the impacts of the applicant's proposed work, prior to a decision on issuance of a Department of the Army permit.

<u>Cultural Resources</u>: Review of the latest published version of the National Register of Historic Places and the Georgia Natural, Archeological and Historic Resources GIS database, indicates that no registered properties or properties listed as eligible for inclusion are located on the project site. Presently unknown archaeological, scientific, prehistorical or historical data may be located at the site and could be affected by the proposed work. The applicant has retained Brockington and Associates to complete a Phase I cultural resources survey of the property. At this time, the Phase I survey has not been submitted for our review.

<u>Endangered Species</u>: A preliminary review of the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service (USFWS) and the National Marine Fisheries Service-Protected Resource Division's (NMFS-PRD) list of Endangered and Threatened Species (IPaC) indicates the following listed species may occur in the project area: Pondberry (*Lindera melissifolia*), Eastern Indigo Snake (*Drymarchon corais couperi*), and Frosted Flatwoods Salamander (*Ambystoma cingulatum*).

Pursuant to Section 7(c) of the Endangered Species Act of 1973, as amended (16 U.S.C. § 1531 et seq.), we request information from the U.S. Department of the Interior, Fish and Wildlife Service, the U.S. Department of Commerce, National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration, National Marine Fisheries Service; or, any other interested party, on whether any species listed or proposed for listing may be present in the area. In addition, we are requesting information from the USFWS whether the project is within 2,500 feet of an active wood stork nesting colony.

<u>Public Interest Review</u>: The decision whether to issue a permit will be based on an evaluation of the probable impact including cumulative impacts of the proposed activity on the public interest. That decision will reflect the national concern for both protection and utilization of important resources. The benefit, which reasonably may be expected to accrue from the proposal, must be balanced against its reasonably foreseeable detriments. All factors which may be relevant to the proposal will be considered, including the cumulative effects thereof; among those are conservation, economics, aesthetics, general environmental concerns, wetlands, historic properties, fish and wildlife values, flood hazards, flood plain values, land use, navigation, shoreline erosion and accretion, recreation, water supply and conservation, water quality, energy needs,

safety, food and fiber production, mineral needs, considerations of property ownership and in general, the needs and welfare of the people.

Consideration of Public Comments: The Corps is soliciting comments from the public; federal, state, and local agencies and officials; Native American Tribes; and other interested parties in order to consider and evaluate the impacts of this proposed activity. Any comments received will be considered by the Corps to determine whether to issue, modify, condition or deny a permit for this proposal. To make this decision, comments are used to assess impacts on endangered species, historic properties, water quality, general environmental effects, and the other public interest factors listed above. Comments are used in the preparation of an Environmental Assessment and/or an Environmental Impact Statement pursuant to the National Environmental Policy Act. Comments are also used to determine the need for a public hearing and to determine the overall public interest of the proposed activity.

Application of Section 404(b)(1) Guidelines: The proposed activity involves the discharge of dredged or fill material into the waters of the United States. The Savannah District's evaluation of the impact of the activity on the public interest will include application of the guidelines promulgated by the Administrator, Environmental Protection Agency, under the authority of Section 404(b) of the Clean Water Act.


<u>Public Hearing</u>: Any person may request, in writing, within the comment period specified in this notice, that a public hearing be held to consider this application for a Department of the Army permit. Requests for public hearings shall state, with particularity, the reasons for requesting a public hearing. The decision whether to hold a public hearing is at the discretion of the District Engineer, or his designated appointee, based on the need for additional substantial information necessary in evaluating the proposed project.

<u>Comment Period</u>: Anyone wishing to comment on this application for a Department of the Army permit should submit their written comments by e-mail to Amy.K.Egoroff@usace.army.mil within 30 days of this notice. Project Location Map










