Expiration of Programmatic General Permit 83
Construction, Maintenance and Modification
Recreational Dock Facilities
Tidal Navigable Waters of the United States
State of Georgia

The Savannah District, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (the Corps) will not reissue Programmatic General Permit 83 (PGP 83), issued August 3, 2017, pursuant to Section 10 of the River and Harbors Act of 1899 (33 U.S.C. 403). This permit will expire on August 3, 2022.


The use of PGP 83 was administered by the Georgia Department of Natural Resources, Coastal Resources Division (GDNR). It authorized the construction, maintenance, and modification of private recreational dock facilities in the tidal navigable waters of the United States (U.S.) located in Effingham, Chatham, Bryan, Liberty, Long, McIntosh, Wayne, Glynn, Brantley, Camden, and Charlton Counties, Georgia. As of August 3, 2022, this permit is no longer valid, and the public will need to apply for a new permit for any work authorized under the August 3, 2017, PGP 83 which was not completed as of the expiration date.

The Corps is currently drafting a Regional General Permit for private recreational dock facilities in tidal areas and anticipates issuance later this year. Currently, to apply for a permit to construct, maintain, or modify a private recreational dock in the tidal, navigable waters of the U.S., please complete Enclosure 2, and submit it, along with plan and profile drawings of the proposed work to the Savannah District, Regulatory Division, Coastal Branch email inbox at CESAS-RD-C@usace.army.mil.
