## PUBLIC NOTICE Savannah District/State of Georgia

Re-issuance of Regional Permit 90
Private Non-Commercial Recreational Ponds
Within the Geographic Limits of Georgia
Savannah District/State of Georgia

The Savannah District, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (Corps), by means of this notice, hereby announces a proposal to re-issue Department of the Army Regional Permit 90 (RP 90) pursuant to Section 404 of the Clean Water Act (33 USC 1344), for a period of five years.

<u>Scope</u>: The scope of RP 90 includes only those activities which are considered to be minor in nature and cause only minimal individual and cumulative impacts. Areas eligible for RP 90 are those non-tidal waters of the United States located within the State of Georgia. All proposals would have to be consistent with the guidelines and limitations set forth in the conditions of the RP.

<u>Description of Activities Proposed for Authorization</u>: RP 90 would authorize the discharge of dredge and/or fill material, incidental to the construction of recreational ponds, with less than five acres in surface area, in non-tidal waters of the United States, in the State of Georgia. To qualify for authorization under RP 90 a proposed pond must impact less than two acres of wetland and/or ephemeral stream; and less than 500 linear feet of intermittent and/or perennial stream.

Other Authorizations: Any jurisdictional activity not authorized by this RP, or that would exceed the limitations of the RP, would require project specific authorization from the Corps in the form of an IP. The District Commander may also require an IP on a case-by-case basis if it is determined that authorization under the RP, for a specific project would be contrary to the public interest.
