Freshwater Fishing Regulations Are Changing Effective July 1, 2012.

Lake Hartwell Changes:

Limit

The daily possession limit for game fish on **Lake Hartwell** is an aggregate of **40** of which:

- not more than **10** may be largemouth, redeye (coosae), spotted, smallmouth bass or their hybrids or any combination;
- not more than **10** may be hybrid bass or striped bass or a combination;
- not more than **10** may be white bass;
- not more than **8** may be walleye or sauger or a combination;
- not more than **20** may be crappie;
- An angler can possess **30** bream per person per day, of which not more than **15** can be redbreast sunfish. Bream includes bluegill, flier, redbreast, warmouth, pumpkinseed, green sunfish, redear and spotted sunfish, and
- not more than **30** may be other freshwater game species not listed here.

Size Limit:

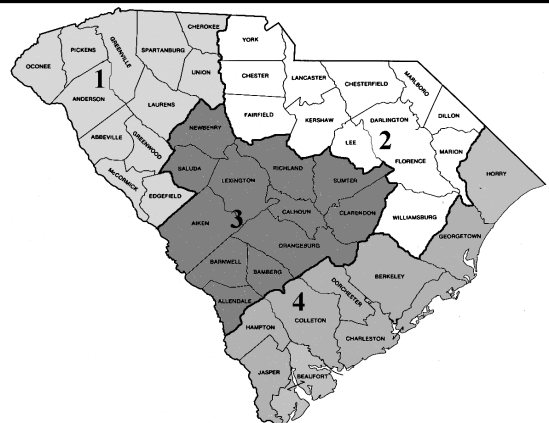
- No largemouth bass less than **12 inches** in total length.
- No crappie less than **8 inches** in total length.
- It is unlawful to possess more than **10** striped bass or hybrid bass or a combination of those a day and **only 3 may be over 26 inches** in total length.
